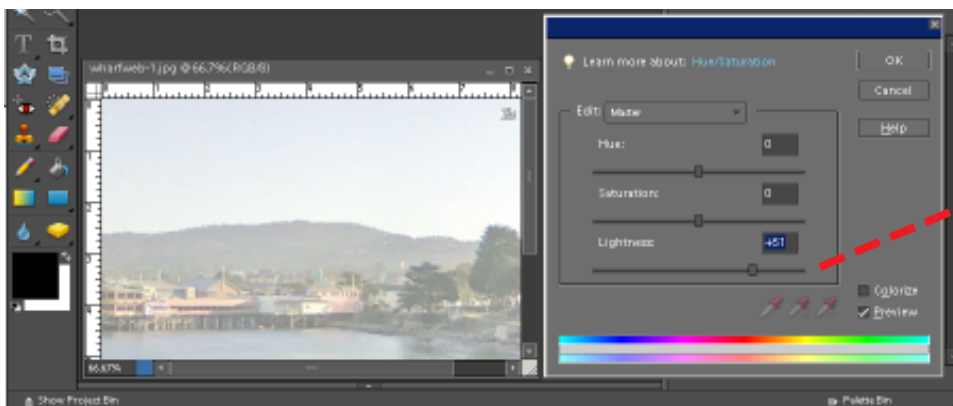
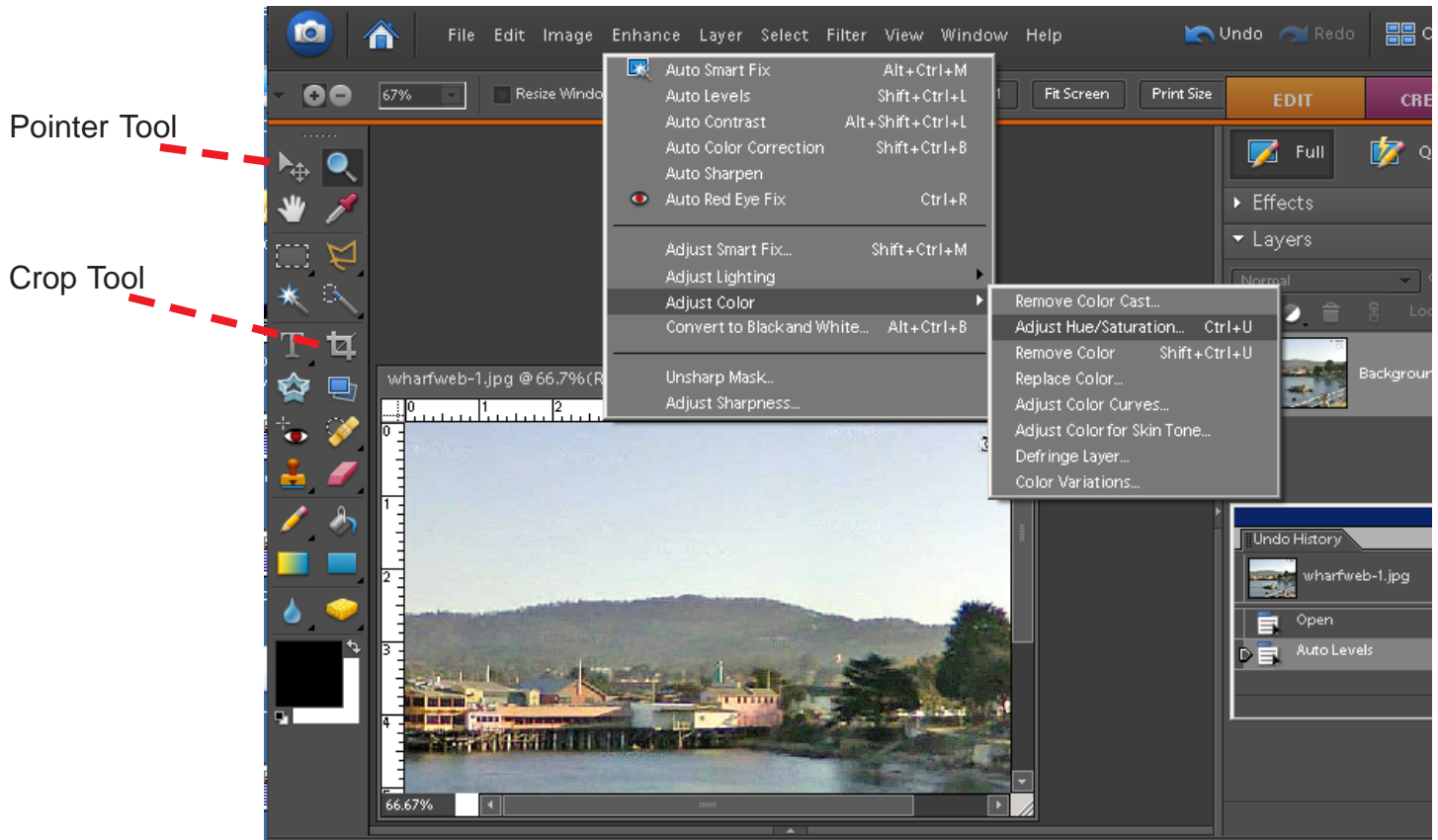


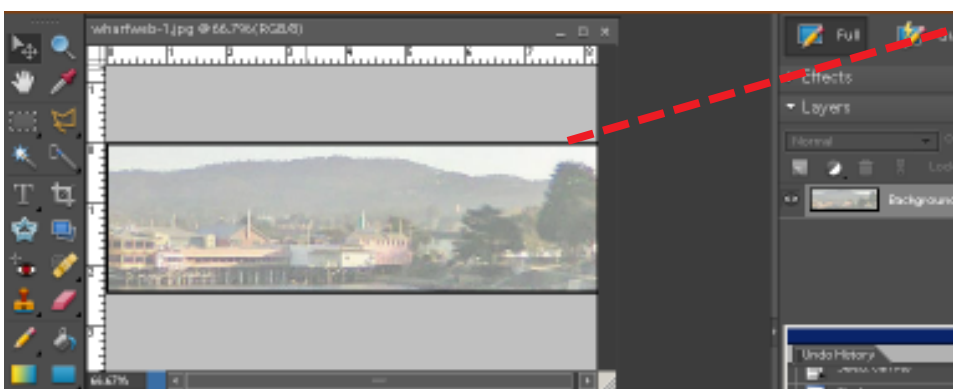
Add an Image on the Header of Your Blog

1. Open a photograph or painting in Photoshop Elements.
2. Go to Menu>Enhance>Adjust Color>Adjust Hue/Saturation.

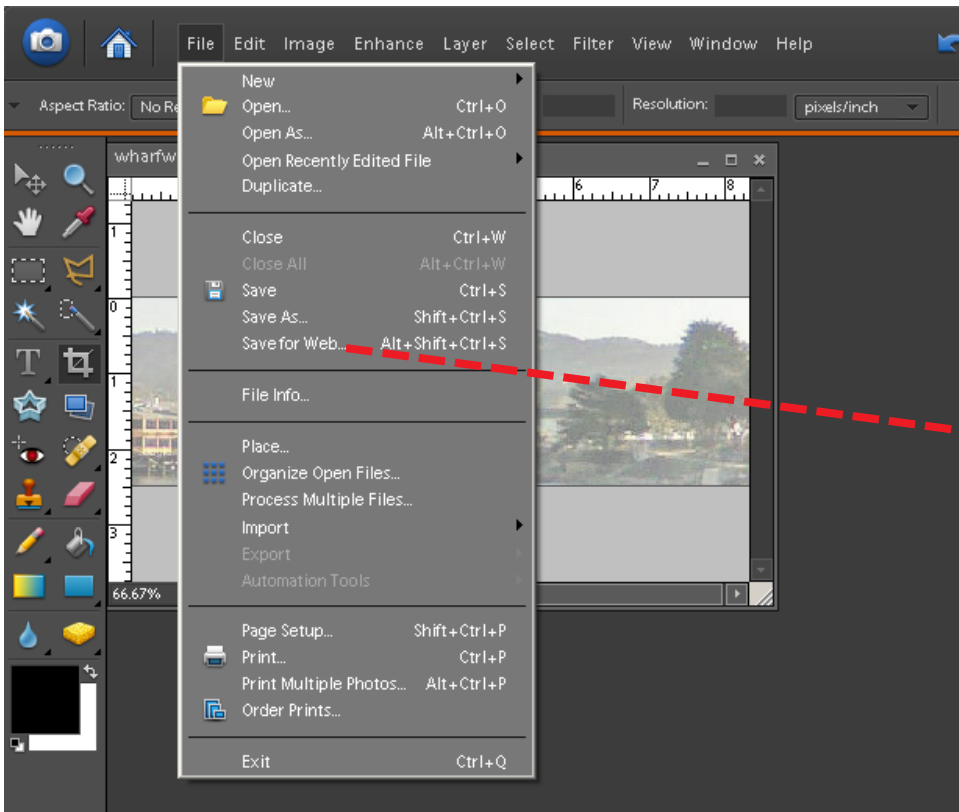


3. The Hue/Saturation box opens.

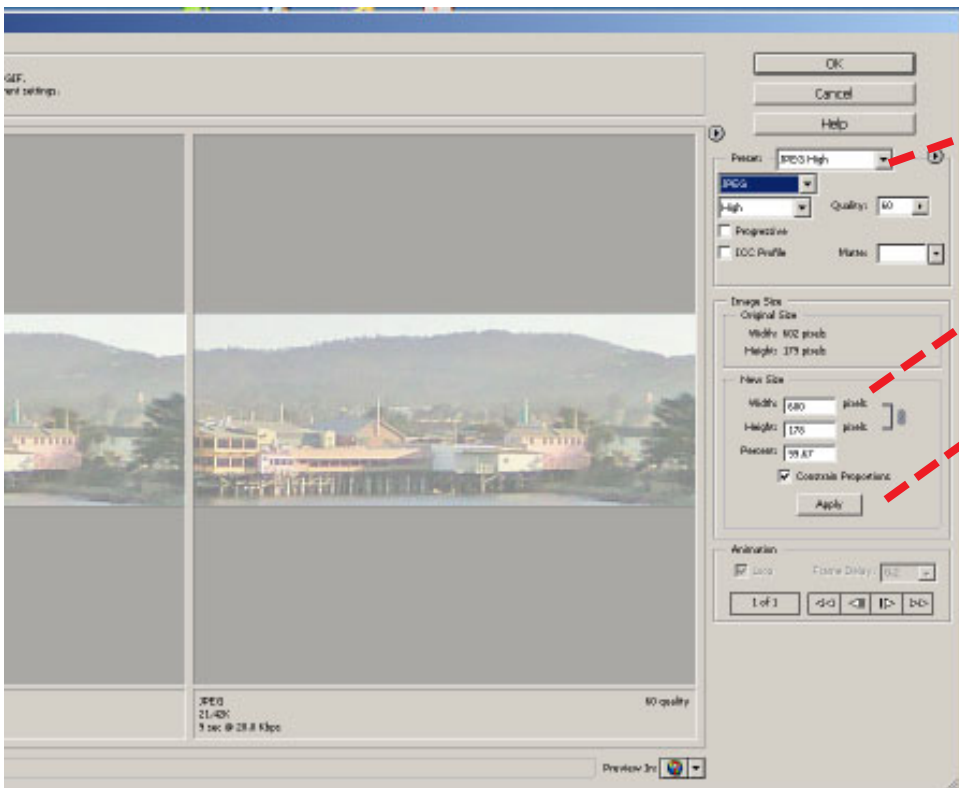
Adjust the Lightness Slider until the photo is softened and light enough for the title of your blog to stand out from it. Click OK.



4. Select the Crop Tool and draw a narrow widescreen frame over the photo. This frame size should fit into the Header section of your blog. Use your cursor to move the frame around and adjust the edges of the area. When finished, double click the image to crop it.



5. Go to File>Save for Web.



6. Change the Preset to JPEG High.

Change New Size to 600, 700, or 800 pixels wide.

Click Apply. You may need to try different widths to fit the image to your template.

7. Go to the top of this "Save for Web" box and click OK. Save the picture to your desktop and be sure to type a new name for this Header picture.

8. Go to page 27 of the the *Step-by-Step Guide to Building a Google Blog* and follow the directions to add the picture to your Header.
